SOUPS



Homemade Chicken Noodle Soup 2499

MAIN COURSES

Salmon with couscous and Greek sauce 8399

This is one big Mediterranean celebration: salmon paired with Moroccan couscous, a Greek-style white sauce, and Sicilian lemon.

Flank Steak with sweet potato fries and Mole sauce 8799

A taste steeped in history. Legend has it that the ancient Angles enjoyed flank steak with sweet potato as early as the 5th century. T-tradition.

Striploin Steak with Ptitim 11999

No, no, dancing striptease lions have nothing to do with it. It's simply the name of one of the finest steak cuts. But we definitely like the way you're thinking!

Osso buco in meat sauce 7999

Meat on meat on more meat — sounds like too much, but only if you're not strong enough! Every Kazakh's dream.

Slow-cooked beef brisket with lentils 7899

The lentils may look like they have their role, but in this dish all attention goes to the tender, juicy beef brisket.

Filet mignon with pepper sauce 6999
